The Golden Paw Group

The *Golden Paw Group* is a select group of friends who have included Animal Adoption Center in their estate and income plans and are providing for the long-term care and maintenance of the beloved pets who must be cared for if their owners pre-decease them.

Our *Golden Paw Life Income Benefits* and *Estate Gifts* programs offer a variety of ways that you can provide for your pets and support the ongoing mission of the Animal Adoption Center and its No-Kill Mission.



Golden Paw Estate Gifts

This plan includes bequests, beneficiary designations, and life insurance policies handled as part of your estate.

The Estate Gifts Plan - An arrangement between you and Animal Adoption Center whereby you designate Animal Adoption Center as a beneficiary in your will.

Life Insurance - Through Life insurance, you can make a large gift to Animal Adoption Center at a small cost. When you donate an old or new policy, life insurance also can create a number of favorable tax advantages to the donor.

Golden Paw Life Income Benefits

With these programs you receive generous life income and significant tax benefits.

Charitable Gift Annuity - pays a fixed annual lifetime income to the donor in exchange for an irrevocable gift of \$5,000 or more.*

Pooled Life Income Fund - provides a flexible lifetime income to the donor in exchange for an irrevocable gift of \$2,000 or more.*

Charitable Remainder Trust - In this type of trust, you irrevocably transfer money or property to the trust and specify the amount of income to be paid, who will receive it, how long payments will continue, and the charity that receives the remainder. These trusts offer significant advantages for the donor such as lifetime income, avoidance of capital gains tax, potential for growth and increased income.

Charitable Lead Trust - allows you to donate income from the trust to Animal Adoption Center for a specified period providing income tax and estate tax advantages, depending on the structure of the trust.



*Provides a substantial charitable deduction and significant capital gains tax advantages if funded with long-term securities.

Animal Adoption Care Society

Includes the Animal Adoption Care Partnership, the President's Advisory Council, and the Animal Disaster Relief Fund.

Animal Adoption Care Partnership
Through this leadership group, friends pledge to make outright gifts totaling at least \$10,000 over five years. These pledges enable AAC to plan more efficiently for the future, and they can provide significant tax benefits.

Animal Disaster Relief Fund

This fund was established for future treatment of thousands of companion animals from the United States and around the world who will be cared for in the event of a natural disaster. The minimum gift is \$1,000.

The President's Advisory Council

All friends who donate between \$1,000 and \$9,999 in a year are recognized for their generosity at a donor appreciation event where they are presented with a special token of our gratitude.
